It is fantastic to see the work has begun on the rebuild of the Community Centre. The work is being undertaken by IMB builders and project management by Arthouse Architecture. The process to award these contracts was lead by the insurance company. The timeframe for the rebuild has the Function Room, Hyatt Room, Kitchen, Bar and Community Room completed by the end of December. There are several planned upgrades to this area which include sound proofing, air conditioning, foyer lighting, history wall, office extension and Community Room upgrade. These improvements have been made possible due to wonderful community support and donations from the Tasman District Council, Sarau Trust and Canterbury Community Trust.



At present the Moutere Hills Community Centre Board are looking into the possibility of developing a community fitness centre. This would involve an 18m x 5.5m extension off the external wall of the sports hall. Support for this project has been extremely positive and we believe it will be a valuable addition to the Community Centre. Before anything can proceed however, we will need to source funding, including sponsorship, and seek Tasman District Council approval.
